

## WHY IS YOUR ROLE IMPORTANT?

CENTRAL SERVICES DIRECTOR	<ul> <li>Serves the Central Services Director by following his vision and direction.</li> <li>Assists the Central Services Director by providing graphics to use for marketing and communication.</li> </ul>
CREATIVE TEAM	<ul> <li>Serves the Creative Team by providing graphics for them to use.</li> <li>Serves them by bringing creative thoughts and ideas to the weekly meeting.</li> </ul>
CAMPUS STAFF	<ul> <li>Serves the campus staff by providing resources for central events, ministries, etc.</li> <li>Helps the campus staff focus their time on ministering to others in their communities.</li> </ul>
